The categories of nonpublic information that we collect from you may include information about your finances, your health to the extent needed for the financial planning process, transactions between you and third parties, and information from consumer reporting agencies, e.g., credit reports. We use this information to help you meet your personal financial goals.

We do not share or disclose customer information to non-affiliated third parties except as permitted or required by law. We hold all personal information provided by you in the strictest confidence, and it is our objective to protect the privacy of all clients. Except as permitted or required by law, we do not share confidential information about clients with non-affiliated parties. If there is a change in this policy, Finances for Life provides you with written notice, and you are provided an opportunity to direct us whether such disclosure is permissible.

## HOW WE COLLECT INFORMATION

To conduct regular business, we may collect personal information from sources such as:

- Data reported by you on applications or other forms you provide to us
- Information about your transactions implemented by us or others
- Information developed as part of analyses or investment advisory services
- Other individuals or entities that you may authorize us to obtain information from, such as your attorney or accountant.

## INFORMATION THAT WE DISCLOSE

We must provide client information within the firm and non-affiliated companies with whom we have entered into agreements to administer, manage, service, and provide related services for client accounts. To provide the utmost service, we may disclose the information below regarding clients as necessary to companies to perform certain services on our behalf.

- Information we receive from you on applications (name, social security number, address, assets, etc.)
- Information about your transactions with us or others (account information, payment history, parties to transactions, etc.)
- Information concerning investment advisory account transactions
- Information about your financial products and services transaction with us

- Mutual fund companies and other product sponsors to generate proposals, reflect available services, execute your investment and otherwise service your accounts.
- Clearing Agencies or custodians through whom we clear and settle your securities transactions
- Companies providing account performance and reporting services on your accounts
- Third-party asset managers with whom we have relationships for the management of customer accounts
- Companies that provide services to us to assist with the maintenance of required books and records or to facilitate client mailings or publications on our behalf;
- State, Federal, and other regulatory and self-regulatory authorities, or under a subpoena for release of information as required by law or regulation
- Other companies, associations, agencies, third parties, and institutions that provide services to us so that we may more effectively and efficiently service your account

Where we share your Nonpublic Personal Information with third parties for the purposes noted above, we ensure that there are contractual agreements with the third party prohibiting them from disclosing your data other than to carry out the purposes for which you disclosed the data, or that such third party is prohibited by law from further sharing your information. Except under the circumstances outlined above, we will not share Nonpublic Personal Information with affiliated or unaffiliated third parties concerning our current or former clients for marketing purposes or otherwise.
